Mens

The closing **weeks of 2025** and the opening **fixtures of 2026** proved to be a demanding period for the **Navan Men's XI**, with **fluctuating** squad availability, **tough conditions**, and a mix of narrow defeats and encouraging performances. Despite the challenges, the **Badgers** showed **resilience, development**, and **flashes of quality** that point to promise for the second half of the season.

Navan Men's XI 1 - 2 Corinthians

Goal Scorers: Ru Clarke

13 December 2025

A **heartbreaking loss** for the travelling **Badgers** as they took on **Corinthians** on the windy slopes of the **Dublin mountains** with only the **bare eleven** available. Having faced the same opposition in the Cup weeks earlier, **Navan approached** the match with **caution** but showed great intent from the outset.

Navan struck early when **Ru Clarke** converted a penalty corner with a **well-placed drag flick** through the keeper's legs. The **Badgers** continued to press and came close to extending their lead, with **Allain Penkula** narrowly missing out on opening his senior scoring account. **Clarke** also went close again with a reverse shot as **halftime approached**. Defensively, **Navan** were **solid**, with **strong tackling** from **Matthew Smith** and excellent midfield work from **Alan Davis**, **David Deasy**, and **Ciaran Kearns**. Debutant **Hugo Gillick** impressed in his first full senior appearance.



As the game wore on, **fatigue** allowed **Corinthians** to dominate possession. A failure to clear the ball led to an equaliser from a **penalty corner**, before a scrappy late goal saw **Corinthians** snatch the win with just three minutes remaining. Despite the disappointment, there were **many positives** to take from a **spirited performance**.

Navan Men's XI 3 - 1 Avoca

17 January 2026

Navan opened their **2026 campaign** with a deserved and **well-worked victory** over **Avoca** in a crucial **bottom-of-the-table clash**. From the first whistle, the **Badgers** looked composed on the ball, passing **confidently** through the lines and controlling large portions of the game.

A strong midfield trio of **Alex McKeever**, **Ciaran Kearns**, and **David Deasy** dictated the tempo, while **Lawrence Amy** delivered an outstanding performance at **right back**, combining **tenacious defending** with **intelligent attacking** runs.

Navan built a **two-goal** cushion through smart finishes from **David Deasy** and **Ben Deasy**, before **Avoca** pulled one back to keep the contest alive. The match took a **sombre** turn when **Amy** suffered a **serious rib injury**, with the club grateful to **Avoca** for their support in **arranging medical care**.



Despite **reshuffling** with a limited bench, Navan showed real **determination**. A beautifully worked team move saw **Jack Linke** finish from close range to seal the **win and secure three valuable points**.

Navan Men's XI 1 - 5 Rathgar

24 January 2025

Navan faced a tough **re-fixed** league fixture against **Rathgar** in **miserable conditions**, with **injuries** continuing to severely impact squad availability. **The Badgers** started brightly, showing good **composure** and creating **early opportunities** down the right flank.

Rathgar gradually adjusted to the **press and capitalised** on their chances, taking a three-goal lead into halftime. Navan responded in the third quarter when **Ru Clarke** swept the ball home following **good link-up** play with **David Deasy**, briefly giving the visitors hope.

However, **Rathgar** maintained control and extended their lead as heavy rain set in. **Despite the scoreline**, there were encouraging spells of possession and improved passing throughout the match. **With injuries** continuing to disrupt selection, Navan will need to **dig deep** as the season progresses.

Navan Ladies 3 - 2 UCD

The **Navan Ladies** kicked off the **New Year** in style with a hard-fought and **victory** over **UCD**, breaking the **deadlock** early in **January** and setting a **positive tone** for the months ahead.

Navan **opened the scoring** from a short corner, with **UCD** initially blocking the effort before **Bronagh** reacted quickest to sweep the loose ball into the net.

The Ladies continued to apply pressure, and their advantage was doubled before halftime when **Christine** struck cleanly from another well-worked short corner to give Navan a strong lead going **into the break**.
